# RECYCLING & GARBAGE INFORMATION

## Things to Know

1. Any recycling, garbage, or rubbish must be placed at the curb for collection no earlier than 6 p.m. on the evening before collection and no later than 5:30 a.m. on the day of the collection.
2. Do not put any recyclables in plastic or brown paper bags.
3. In the event of heavy snow, flooding, or extreme weather conditions, your recyclables and garbage will be collected on your next designated recycling or garbage day.

## White Goods / Heavy Metal Items

Hackensack residents must purchase a sticker for the collection of white good items ie. stoves, refrigerators, washers, dryers, bed frames, file cabinets. The cost of the sticker is \$10.00 per item. Stickers are available at the D.P.W. office located at 120 East Broadway. Your Checks or money order should be made payable to the City of Hackensack. No cash will be accepted. Anyone placing white goods at the curb without a sticker will receive a summons. All residents are responsible for what is placed at the curb in front of their homes. ## Cosas a Saber

### TIRES

Can be brought to the Public Works Facility at 120 East Broadway. A nominal fee of \$3.00 per car tire and \$5.00 per truck tire will be charged. No rims.

### RUBBISH

Only 2 furniture items or 2 cans or bags of debris can be put at curb for collection.

### HOUSEHOLD ELECTRONICS

Computers, TV's, Batteries, Electronic equipment, Vacuums, Toasters & Microwaves etc. can be brought to the Recycling Center at 15 Green Street. THERE WILL BE NO CURBSIDE PICKUP OF THESE ITEMS.

### LLANTAS

Glass, tin, aluminum, and plastic, mixed. No paper or plastic bags.

### CARDBOARD

Crushed and tied into bundles. (Max. 25 lbs.)

### NEWSPAPERS

Tied into bundles no taller than 12 inches in height.

### JUNK MAIL

Place at curb in a reusable container.

### NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL

Kitchen cabinets, sheetrock & file cabinets etc

### RECICLAJE

Todo el reciclaje será recogido en el día designado.

### MEZCLADO

Vidrio, latas aluminio y plástico, mezclado. No bolsas de papel ni bolsa de plástico.

### CARTÓN





# DEPARTMENTS & SERVICES

## POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Hackensack Police Department provides a multitude of services regarding enforcement, safety and assistance to the community. The Department is comprised of 116 sworn officers, 8 civilian dispatchers, 11 Class II officers and 15 civilian employees. It also employs 45 part time crossing guards and has a volunteer special law enforcement officer (HCOP) program of 50 members. The volunteers assist with traffic control and other duties.

The Department also has a very active Outreach Program that provides numerous programs to work in partnership with the community. Among them are the Neighborhood Block Watch Program, SRO, Youth Academy.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Hackensack Fire Department responds to fire alarms, motor vehicle accidents, rescue calls, hazardous materials incidents, first responder medical calls, and all other types of emergencies. Our Department has recently been evaluated by the Insurance Service Organization resulting in a classification upgrade. The Hackensack Fire Department now has the rare distinction as an I.S.O Class #1 Fire Department. This prestigious classification has only been awarded to 2 Fire Departments in New Jersey and only 61 in the United States of America.

The department staffs four Engine Companies, one Truck Company and one Rescue Company under the command of a Deputy Chief 24 hours a day, seven days a week. All companies carry automatic defibrillators and the anti-opiate overdose drug Narcan for cardiac arrest and overdose victims.

The department also has a special operation unit that can be called for confined space rescue, high-angle rescue, trench rescue and building collapse emergencies. Other functions handled by the Fire Department include hazardous materials incidents, emergency management, a communications center, a fire prevention bureau, a signal systems electrical division, and a fire apparatus repair shop. ## BUILDING & LAND USE DEPARTMENT

## RECYCLING AND SANITATION

The City of Hackensack recycles commingled glass, tin, aluminum, and plastic placed in an open container (No Plastic Bags); newspaper tied in bundles; corrugated cardboard crushed and tied in bundles; and junk mail in an open container or tied in a bundle. Junk mail includes all paper products, cereal boxes, magazines, phone books, soft cover books and hard cover books with covers removed. Residents are required to pay \$10 (**Check or Money Order only**) for the collection of each white good item. A white good is a metal object such as appliances, desks, shelving, etc. To arrange for a white good collection, please come to the recycling office located on the second floor of the Department of Public Works complex at 120 East Broadway or send a check or money order to City of Hackensack Sanitation Department, 120 E. Broadway, Hackensack, NJ 07601. You will receive a sticker to be placed on the item and a date for collection.

Residential recycling is collected once a week on your current garbage day. Batteries, Electronic Waste (small appliances, TV's, computers etc.), and fluorescent bulbs are no longer collected with rubbish but can be dropped off at the DPW Recycling Center located at 15 Green Street, **Monday through Friday 8am - 4pm and Saturdays 8am - 1pm**.
